## Step 1

**SENSITISING** – Activities aimed at guiding participants to understand a topic, such as for instance reviewing workshop material can sometimes be carried out prior to the workshop itself.

## Step 2

**INTRODUCTION** – helps to start building a relationship amongst the participants – icebreakers are a great way of doing this.

## Step 3

**IMMERSION** – activities such as word games, and collages which create a shared understanding for the rest of the workshop.

## Step 4

**GENERATION** – Activities such as scenario building which help develop ideas, sometimes by analysing existing ideas and solutions.

## Step 5

**REFLECTION** – help to create a sense of progress at the end of the workshop and to validate and finalise the results of the workshop.
